Dear Sir/Madam,

Most of the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas have re-opened after summer vacation on 1st July 2016. Hope all the activities are geared up to receive the students and to carry out activities as planned to achieve the target of Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti. I would also like to welcome all new students of Class-VI.

I would like to exhort all of you, i.e. Principals, Vice-Principals, PGT, TGT, creative Teachers, non-teaching staff, students, Alumni & parents to create better landscape and ambience for your campus. Already we have well earmarked campus, but requiring better greenery. Monsoon has already arrived in most parts of the country. Now we have the opportunity to green it for better ambience and inculcating better sensitiveness towards nature.

Accordingly, following action may be initiated immediately: -

1. Concerned Principals shall request concerned Deputy Conservator of Forest /DFOs for good qualities planting materials. In rare cases, planting material may be procured from other nurseries, however on advice of DCF/DFOs of the area.
2. We should take pledge to plant 2000 sapling in to 2016-17 by involving all stake holder including, Teacher, students, Alumni & Parents.
3. Digging of pits should be on voluntary basis through "SHRAMDAN" i.e. two pit per person.
4. The plants so planted shall have joint ownership of teachers and students i.e. each five plant may be allotted to one student and 60 plants (i.e. 12 students) will be supervised by one teacher. This will establish organic linkage between plants, students, Teachers and other stake holders.
5. The selection of species shall be done in such a way that it has mixture of shade bearing trees like Neem, Arjun site, suitable fruit bearing trees like Mango, Apple, Jamun etc. ornamental trees like Gulmohar, Alstonia etc.
6. Planting of sapling will be done by teachers, students alumni and parents on their own under the supervision of experts/officials from Forest Department, Principals will accordingly request, District Forest Officials in this regard.

7. Officials & staffs of ROs and clusters will also join the movement of greetings/planting of saplings in nearby schools.

The plantation drive will go on throughout July/August, 2016. I hope all of us will enjoy greening of our campus and create better ambience for all living therein.
